Menu of Creative Homework Challenge Ideas

- Calculate how many litres of water it takes to fill your bath. Which uses less water, the shower or the bath? How can you find out?
- Draw a map of Europe and place the countries and their capitals on it.
- Draw a range of plants in your garden or local area. Carry out research to find out what they are called.
- Research about seasonal plants. Choose one of them and draw what they look like during different seasons.
