- Research and write about the tools used during the Stone Age to the Iron Age.
- Create your own explanation text about a topic of your choice, e.g. why school uniforms are worn or why dinosaurs are extinct.
- Write a diary entry from the point of view of an archaeologist who has just made an amazing discovery.
- Draw or paint a picture of a dragon and label with beautiful description, e.g. ebony wings as light as a feather.
