Creative homework certificates

Bronze - if you complete 1 piece of homework this half term.

Silver - if you complete 2 pieces of homework this half term.

Gold - if you complete 3 pieces of homework this half term.

Earn 1 **Children's University** credit for each creative piece completed. Must be handed in with a completed reflection sheet.

Menu of Creative Homework Challenges

- Create a flow chart or design a poster to explain pollination and dispersal of plants and flowers.
- Choose a scene from your favourite movie. Write a play script for your chosen scene.
- Write a fact file on Roald Dahl.
- To create a poster on being healthy. Think about a range of topics such as diet, lifestyle, etc.
- Research British inventors. Write what they are famous for inventing and present your findings on a poster.

Writing

We will:

- Explore play scripts based on Roald Dahl's novel, Charlie and The Chocolate Factory.
- Write a play script using inspiration from the novel and using chocolate to help us with our creativity.

Science

We will learn:

- Pollination and dispersal of plants and flowers.
- How plants change over the course of the year in different seasons.
- What seeds we find throughout the year
- About different colours of berries and various species of insects that visit plants.

Maths

We will:

- explore number and place value of 3 digit numbers
- learn addition of pairs of 2-digit and 3-digit numbers mentally
- learn to multiply numbers between 10 and 25
- learn how to read the time on both a digital and analogue clocks
- explore doubling and halving numbers up to 100
